An Australian Apprenticeship includes both apprenticeships and traineeships and combines paid employment with gaining a nationally recognised qualification. Australian Apprenticeships are 'competency based' which means training can be completed as soon as the required skill level in the qualification is reached.

[Skills Canberra Australian Apprentices Completion Payment](#)

All eligible Skilled Capital students, and eligible Australian Apprentices (who commenced after 1 January 2016), can claim a completion payment of \$300 (for Skill Sets the completion payment is \$100). To qualify, you must not have completed more than 50% of your training via Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or Credit Transfer.
